On top of their core function as print spoolers, the two ISD print appliance families operate as ThinPrint Gateways. ISD300 models attach up to 50 printers to the network, the larger ISD400 and ISD410 are able to provide connectivity for up to 150 printers. Users realize cost savings as outlets and branch offices do not require a local print server or PC functioning as ThinPrint .print Client. Utilizing TPGs and ISD Intelligent Spooling Devices, the printers attached via these devices do not require a ThinPrint .print Client. Interested parties may order test samples directly from SEH.
